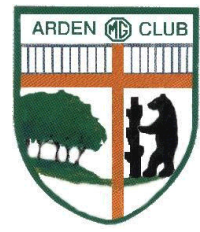

GWR Broadway Station Donation



The Arden MG Club's Heritage Run has been an annual event since the first run in 1993, which went from Stratford-upon-Avon to finish at the newly opened Heritage Motor Centre in Gaydon – hence the name of the run. Each year when a surplus is made a donation is made to various local or transport related charities. The 2014 run ended at the National Memorial Arboretum, which was chosen to commemorate the start of the First World War in 1914. The charity selected by the members of the club was for the rebuilding of the GWR station in Broadway. The GWR (Gloucester Warwickshire Railway) currently runs from Toddington through to Cheltenham Racecourse, but they have plans to extend in the opposite direction towards Broadway. Our donation of £250 will go towards the rebuilding of the station at Broadway and the photo shows our cheque being presented to Bill Britton of the Broadway Station Appeal by Richard Workman the Chairman of the Heritage Run Committee.

The run for 2015 is planned for Sunday 7th June and will revert to the more regular starting point of Evesham Country Park. The route will meander through the Worcestershire & Herefordshire lanes to finish at Eastnor Castle, where a dedicated parking area has been set aside for the MGs to assemble in. The entry fee for the run is £25, which will include admission to the grounds at Eastnor Castle for two people, 'Tulip' style route book and the full colour rally plate (with cable ties).
